

Prayers for Strength, Wisdom, Guidance, and Peace

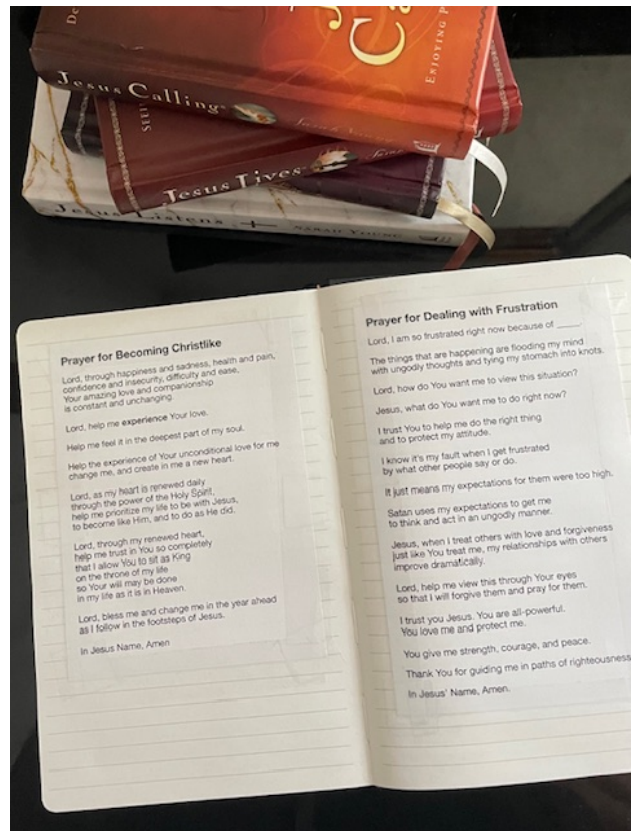
Here's some prayers that I've been reading every day since January 2025. They've been very helpful. I print them, cut them and tape them to my journals.

General Prayer to Ask Who I Need to Forgive

Heavenly Father, You had Your Beloved Son Jesus Christ, killed as a sacrifice for my sins.

Your kindness and mercy toward me is amazing! Thank you!

I confess I have not extended that same kindness and mercy to others.

Because of your forgiveness and all else You've done for me through the blood of Jesus Christ, I now choose to forgive others' behaviors that have provoked negative beliefs, judgements and painful feelings that I've held onto.

I ask You Holy Spirit, to reveal to me any person I now need to forgive.

(Make a list of names that come to mind.)

Prayers to *Begin* Forgiveness Other People

Heavenly Father, I confess that suppressing the beliefs and feelings provoked by other people's offenses poison me and my relationships.

Therefore, I welcome Your Holy Spirit to bring those beliefs and feelings to the surface as I forgive.

Now, Lord, please bring to my mind a specific incident or painful memory that I need to forgive (Name of Person) for.

Thank you.

In Jesus' Name.

Amen

Lord, I choose to forgive (Name) for (Describe what they said and did to hurt me).

I expected (Tell God what I expected from this person - how I expected them to behave instead - what I expected to happen instead of what happened.)

However, I do choose to forgive (Name) even though (he/she) didn't live up to my expectations, and even though, because of this offense, I believed or judged that (whatever I judged about the person.)

Even though it made me feel (Describe the pain I felt).

In spite of these feelings and judgements, Lord, by your grace and with hope and faith in Your love for me and what you alone can do in my soul, I forgive (Name) unconditionally for these things that hurt me.

In Jesus' name, I renounce the hurtful, negative words that (Name) spoke to me and about me.

Specifically I renounce that (tell what he or she said).

I break agreement with every negative, hurtful word.
These words are now null and void.

I apply your blood, Lord Jesus, to break the curse and power of these words from my life.

I loose - remove and utterly destroy their influence and harm from my body, spirit, soul - especially my attitudes, mindsets, emotions, memories, relationships and future.

I bind all that I am to the life-giving words You, my Creator, spoke into me when You made me in my mother's womb.

Lord, please remind me if there is another specific incident or painful memory for which I need to forgive (Name).

Prayers to **Complete** Forgiveness of other People

I confess, Lord, I have held on to my hurt, resentment, anger, bitterness, expectations and my judgements regarding these offenses.

I have been unforgiving toward (Name). I agree with You - this has kept me from the fullness of Your forgiveness of me.

Heavenly Father, You nailed your charges against me to the cross of Christ.

In response, I now bring to You every charge I have held against (Name) because of these offenses.

I ask You to nail these charges to the cross of Christ along with my sins. (picture it)

I confess that the blood of Christ's death is enough to wash them away and to heal my self - spirit, soul and body - of their pain and influence.

I give up the right to ever charge (Name) again for these offenses.
(Name) now owes me nothing relating to these offenses.

I confess, Lord Jesus, that you alone are (Name's) and my judge and I am not.

Therefore, I lay into Your nail-scarred hands every negative judgement I have held against (Name) because of these offenses. (picture doing this)

In Jesus' name, I loose (Name) from the power of any negative, unloving words I have spoken toward or about (him/her) because of these offenses. I renounce those words.

I call them null and void. I break their power over (Name's) spirit, soul and body.

I declare that (Name) is not responsible to me for the offenses which (his/her) behavior provoked in me.

Instead, I assume all responsibility for choosing to pick up and hold on to these offenses.

Heavenly Father, I cancel any blame I've placed on You. I drop every charge and judgement I've held against You for permitting these things to happen to me.

As I have now forgiven (Name) for these offenses, I receive Your forgiveness and cleansing for every wrong attitude, action and reaction associated with these offenses.

I also forgive myself for holding on to these feelings and offenses.
I didn't know any better.

(Put my hand over my heart)

In Jesus' Name, I speak to my own heart now.

I command you, heart, to loose your hold on any bitter root that these offenses have fed. Let it go and send it away!

By Your grace, Father God, I bind my heart instead, to Your implanted word that is able to save my soul and to Your love and grace.

In Jesus' name, I loose - remove and utterly destroy - all work or influence of the enemy brought into my life because of these offenses or my unforgiveness of them.

I also loose - remove and utterly destroy the assignment of any demon or unGodly ruler, authority, cosmic power over this present darkness or spiritual force of evil set against me because of these offenses or my unforgiveness of them.

I also renounce and loose - remove and utterly destroy - every negative effect these offenses have had on my spirit, soul, body and relationships.

Holy Spirit, please come now and heal my body, spirit and soul - especially my mindsets, attitudes, emotions, memories and even my DNA - from all the damage and defilement caused by these offenses.

I loose - remove and utterly destroy - the effects on my body of every negative emotion caused by these offenses.

Fill every place in my self - spirit, soul and body - that I have emptied as I've forgiven (Name) with Your love and goodness.

Thank You, Father, for my healing.

In obedience to Your Son, I now choose to bless (Name).

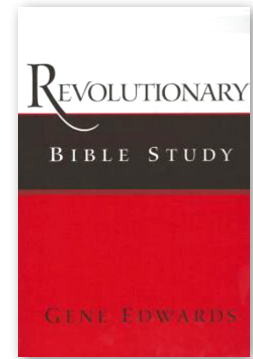
